Korogocho: Library & ICT Centre 2015/2018

Project successfully completed in partnership with Comboni missionaries and co-financed by MAE:

- New Library of 200 sq.m.
- 1,685 users
- 15,000 books
- New ICT Centre
- 17 PCs + 1 Printer
- 6 classrooms
- Book-lending programme












Korogocho: Training Centre 2016/2019

Successful project in partnership with Comboni missionaries and co-financed by MAE:

- 2 Workshops of 150 sq.m. each completed: electrical, plumbing and carpentry
- Training Centre of 2 floors and 535 sq.m. nearly completed
- Beneficiaries: street youths of Korogocho











Madagascar: School and Community Centre 2017/2019

Successful project in partnership with EDI Madagascar and co-financed by MAE:

- Building of 150 sq.m. nearly completed
- Beneficiaries: about 150 children and 550 adults











Luxembourg: Wings for Women / Integration of Refugees 2016/2017

Project completed at the Weilerbach Centre (OLAI) and co-financed by Oeuvre Nationale de Secours Grande-Duchesse Charlotte:

- Pilot project in a difficult context
- 20 women refugees provided with trainings, workshops and social activities
- Important learning points for a potential future project:
 - Understanding the context
 - Involving the beneficiaries in the project design and objectives
 - Stronger project management skills













In least-developed countries - MADAGASCAR, UGANDA (OECD - DAC, 2018)

- → Focus on marginalized communities
- → Providing infrastructure to complement insufficient government services
- → Empowering beneficiary communities by providing essential tools and training

SECTORS: Education, vocational training (incl. agriculture and food security)



Our strategy for interventions in the South

In lower middle-income countries - KENYA (OECD - DAC, 2018)

\rightarrow Shift to a human rights based approach:

- \rightarrow Focus on marginalized communities
- → Interventions aimed at promoting better education and raising awareness
- → Empowering beneficiary communities by building the right capacities to help them claim their basic rights



Our strategy for interventions in the North

 \rightarrow Raising awareness about living conditions in other parts of the world

→ Promoting a dialogue between people from different backgrounds

→ Encouraging debate on taking action and the responsibility of people in the North
